Dragon Parade Information

Dear Parade Participants:

Thank you for your participation in the 2020 Dragon Parade for the Lunar New Year on Sunday, February 9, 2020 at 11:00 am.

We will have numerous organizations participating in the parade and we are delighted that you will be a part of this event. Below are some instructions that we are asking that you follow concerning the parade:

Start Up Staging: Parking lot at 1203 N Mills Ave, Orlando, FL 32803 (corner of Mills Ave and Lake Highland Drive)

Arrival Time: 10:00 am. Please proceed to the parking lot at 1203 N Mills Ave, Orlando, FL 32803 (corner of Mills Ave and Lake Highland Drive) register your organization. There is only one check-in Entry Location in the staging area. Our parade volunteers will assist you with finding your assigned space in the staging area. (Only parade participants and vehicles will be allowed in the assigned staging area so if you are not participating please plan to drop your participant off and if you are helping with decoration please plan to park nearby and walk back to the staging area.)

Street Block: 10:00 am

Line – Up: 10:15 am (Your assigned staging and line-up number will be given out when you arrive)

Kick Off: 11:00 am

Where: Parade will start at the corner of Lake Highland Drive and N. Mills Ave (Staging area will be at the parking lot at the corner of Lake Highland Drive and N. Mills Ave)

Parade Units: Each parade entry is allowed one vehicle except approved by the Dragon Parade Committee in advance. Walking participants are not limited.

Parade Route: Will start at the corner of Lake Highland Drive and N. Mills Ave and head West left turns at N. Thornton Ave, heading south and ends at the parking lot at 728 N. Thornton Ave, Orlando, FL 32803.



Viewing: Both sides of N Thornton Ave.

Decoration & Performance: All parade units and signs are encouraged to display something about the Lunar New Year and/or the Year of the Rat. Please provide some background music to your parade unit to make it lively. All performing units please pause about 1 minute in every intersection during the parade route. You can pass out candies or cookies to the audiences but please DO NOT throw them.
